## Howard Remains Unbeaten with 11<sup>th</sup> End Win

After defeating Robert Rumfeldt's rink 8 to 2 in six ends, Glenn Howard's team posted its second win of the day yesterday in a nailbiter against Rob Lobel's rink. Down two, coming home without the hammer, Howard tied it at 7 to force the extra end. In the 11th end, Lobel's first rock chipped out his own shot rock in the 4 foot and left Howard with four rocks in front of the tee line. Howard attempted to cover so Lobel couldn't draw to the button, but left an opening. Lobel appeared to throw a beautiful draw shot, but it stopped short, leaving Howard with three and the win.

A Lobel win in that game would have been a real spoiler as Lobel was winless leading up to it. That says a lot for the level of play at this competition—on any given day any team has the potential to win.

In his third game of the day, Howard met Bryan Cochrane's rink, the only other undefeated team at the start of the seventh draw. The end result was an 8 to 3 victory for the seemingly unstoppable Howard squad.

Since Howard drew his bye on the final day, he will only have one game remaining after today's draws. With a 7-0 record, if he is successful in securing one win today, Howard's rink can put a lock on a playoff spot. The four-time consecutive Tankard champion's first opponent today is Team Ciasnocha who is currently 2-4 and the second is Team Frans at 4-3.

Hanging onto a 5-1 record and tied for the second position at today's outset, Bryan Cochrane has more than doubled his final round robin count of 2 wins in last year's Woodstock Tankard.

Behind 6 to 4 yesterday in the 8th end against Team Frans, the Cochrane team managed to count three in the 10th following a blank end in the 9th. This was a crucial win that kept him ahead of Team Frans in the standings. At the completion of the seventh draw, Team Frans was tied at 4-3 with Team Rumfeldt.

The race is on to be one of the teams to finish in the top four positions, the only teams that will qualify for the playoff round. Still looking strong is Peter Corner's team with only one loss, that to Glenn Howard's rink in a close 5-4 Tuesday match. Team Corner defeated Young 8 to 7 and Bice 9 to 7 in their two matches yesterday. Frans and Rumfeldt are pushing to climb the rung, but it is still too soon to make predictions with this strong field of competitors.

## Team Ziola—Highland Country Club



After three days of play, experienced curler Kirk Ziola is looking to improve upon his record of 2 wins and 5 losses. Beginning day three with a 9 to 7 win over Team Gardner, Team Ziola were not able to put together a second victory in draw six against Team Young or in draw seven against Team Bice.

Ziola, in his sixth appearance at the Ontario Provincial Championship, was the Saskatchewan representative at the 1983 Brier. Counting his Saskatchewan days, he has made it to provincials 13 times.

Third Darcy Tomchick has curled with Ziola for ten years, appearing at the Tankard with him in 2000, 2004, and 2005 in addition to this year.

Second is Scott McDonald who has 15 years of curling experience, three of them with Ziola.

Newcomer to the team is lead Paul Moffatt, a former Kingston curler. He played Junior out of Catarauqui Golf and Country Club on a rink that included Napanee native Rob Dickson.

## Team Rumfeldt—Guelph Curling Club

Sitting at two wins and two losses to start the day on Wednesday, Robert Rumfeldt was hoping that his team could spring into the top half of the standings with three wins. However, his first meeting was with Team Howard who showed no mercy.

In his second game yesterday, tied at 5 after eight ends, Team Rumfeldt scored two in the 9th which was enough to secure the win. The third game of the day for the Rumfeldt team was yet another win, against Team Young, which tied them with Team Frans for fourth place at 4-3.

Rumfeldt's team qualified for the Tankard through the West Challenge route. Rumfeldt himself has been at Ontario Tankards seven other times, winning in 1996 and competing at the Brier as a second for Bob Ingram. His team uses a five man roster which includes third Scott Hodgson, a former OUAA champion in 2003 and finalist in the 1994 Ontario Mixed Championship. His other teammates, Greg Robinson, Nolan Sims, and Jeff Robinson were all on the 1992 Ontario Junior Men's Championship team.



## Team Young—Brantford Golf & Country Club



Jay Young's team split their first two games of day three, then suffered another loss by a score of 8 to 4 to Team Rumfeldt.

The morning match against a strong Team Corner was a disappointing loss as they were able to tie the game in the ninth end on a two point steal. Corner then closed with a one count to win 8 to 7. At the end of the day on Wednesday, Young's team was in the middle of the field with 2 wins and four losses, the same as Teams Bice and Ciasnocha. With four games to go, they are not out of the running.

Skip Jason Young was a 1999 World Junior Champion, finished second at the 2001 Canadian Mixed Championship and was the third on Heath McCormick's team in the 2007 Provincial Championship. Together for three years, this team includes third Chad Allen, Chad Simpson and Tyler Morgan who have all curled for more than 20 years, but are making their first Tankard appearance. Rob Dickson, picked up as a spare by Team Young, curled in Wednesday's third draw, as did his older brother, Scott, who was called upon to play second with Team Gardner.
