## Howard finishes round robin with perfect record

With five counters in the first end last night against Chris Gardner's team, the Glenn Howard rink easily wrapped up a first place finish and a perfect round robin record. He will continue his quest for a fifth consecutive Ontario Tankard Championship when he meets Team Cochrane in the 2:00 pm time slot today. The winner of that game will advance to the final on Sunday.

Bryan Cochrane's team finished at 9-1 in the round robin to secure second place with two wins yesterday, the first a score of 10 to 4 against Team Bice and the second 9 to 6 against Team Corner. In the Cochrane-Corner game at 7:00 pm, Bryan Cochrane and his teammates—third Rich Moffatt, second Colin Dow, and lead John Steski—scored three in the first end and stole one in the

second to take control of the game. Another three in the sixth all but sealed the victory and a right to play Glenn Howard's rink in the one-two Page game.

With the loss, Peter Corner fell to 7-3 and will face Robert Rumfeldt, also 7-3, in the three-four Page playoff game at 7:00 pm today. Rumfeldt will have the hammer by virtue of his defeat of Corner in round robin play. The winner will advance to Sunday's semi-final at 9:30 am against the loser of today's Howard-Cochrane game.

Joe Frans just missed the playoffs finishing 6-4 with two wins on Friday, his final game going to an extra end.

Making an appearance at the Strathcona Paper Centre tonight is distinguished curler Pat Ryan;

however, his performance will not be on the ice. He and daughter Lynsay are accomplished musicians providing the evening's entertainment in the Ice Hut Lounge.

Ryan's career highlights in curling include:

- three time Canadian champion—1988, 1989, 1993
- a perfect record of 12-0 at the 1988 Brier
- two time World Champion—1989, 1994
- played in the Brier in four different decades (70s, 80s, 90s and 00s), the first in 1979
- 1986 Canadian Mixed Champion
- 2007 Canadian Senior Champion
- 2008 World Senior Champion

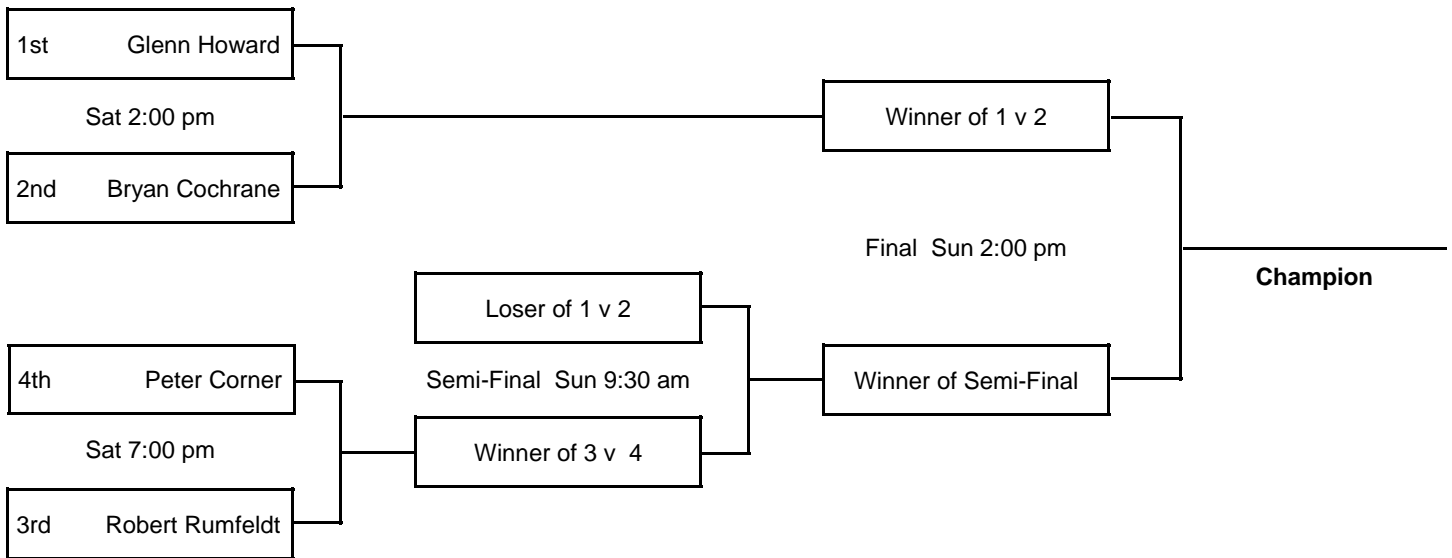

## Special Olympics Provincial Finals

For the eleventh year, Special Olympics Ontario has teamed up with the Ontario Curling Association to have the Special Olympic provincial championship hosted in conjunction with the Tankard. Four teams qualified at their Regional Competitions to get to this event—Brampton and Kingston in the A Division Final, Lindsay and London in the B Final.

Members of Napanee's own Special Olympic curling team will carry the banners during the opening ceremony to lead the teams onto the ice. According to coach Marilyn Elliott, the team "had one of our better years this season." They qualified in the zone competition to compete at the Regionals where they were defeated by the same Lindsay team that is competing here today. That game was "a close one as we were tied coming home but Lindsay managed to take two in the last end."

Be sure to take in the games at 5:00 pm today as these special athletes show us what sportsmanship and enthusiasm are all about. One of the London curlers, Julie Timmermans, expressed how she feels about curling: "I love all of the great friends that I have met through sports. I love to compete, but I love the people I have made friends with and I cheer them on too."
